- All classes taught at college preparatory level or higher. Students are admitted to Honors/AP courses based on academic performance, teacher recommendation, and department approval. **Dual Enrollment** courses from Rio Salado Community College are offered in some subject areas. We follow an 80-minute course **block schedule**.
- Honors courses receive additional .5 additional grade point.
- Advanced Placement courses receive 1 additional grade point.
- **Fine Arts** requirement of 2.5 credits is elevated and may affect number of AP/Honors courses taken over four years.
